

# Welcome

As your family approaches our check-in areas, you will be greeted by a member of our Public Kids Team. You will receive a name tag for your child and a corresponding security tag for yourself at our computerized check-in location. Please alert check-in personnel of any information that will help in caring for your child, such as allergies and special needs. You will, then, take your child to their designated room that is printed on the child's name tag. Please note that parents are not allowed in the Public Kids areas without the corresponding security tag. All Public Teammates have been through a screening process to ensure the safety of your child.

# What to Expect in Public Kids - Preschool

#### What is Public Kids - Preschool?

Our Public Kids ministry serves families by providing safe and fun environments for our children from birth- four years old. Our Team engages kids through age-appropriate worship, Bible teaching, and activities to reinforce the lesson.

A Public Kids teammate will be at the security checkpoint ready to receive your child and take them to the appropriate classroom. If you would like more information on our classrooms please contact the Public Kids Director.

After you have completed the check-in process, wave a quick good-bye and head into the worship gathering. As you know, it is common for little ones to cry when a parent leaves. This, typically, does not last long. Separation will become easier over time. Our leaders will immediately engage your child in a toy or activity and ensure your child that you will return soon. If your child cries for an extended period of time, we will text you using the number that corresponds to the one on your security tag.

### **Babies**

### **Necessary Items**

When packing a diaper bag for your child, please include the following items:

- Two or three disposable diapers
- An extra change of clothes
- A bottle of milk, formula, juice or water

Please label all personal items (including pacifiers and bottles/ sippy cups) with your child's first and last name before arriving at your child's class. This helps know which items belong to your child.

### **Snacks**

Snacks are provided for our crawlers and walkers. The food items consist of Gerber Graduate Puffs. Again, please inform the check-in team of any allergies during the check-in process.

Allergy alerts will be entered into our check-in system and displayed on your child's name tag.

### Curriculum

We believe that even our littlest ones can learn about the love of Christ! Regular learning experiences are planned and lessons are reinforced with songs, Bible thoughts, and supervised activities designed with the ability of your child in mind.

### **Pick-up Procedure**

When the time comes to pick up your child, please return to the appropriate room and present your security tag to the teammate at the door. The tag will be matched to your child's name tag before he/she will be released into your care. A child will not be able to leave the room with a parent, without the presentation of the security tag. In the event you lose your security tag, you will be asked to show proper identification before your child is returned to you. Please make sure that you have all of your child's belongings with you before you leave.
